GUIDE TO THE MASHA AND WILLIAM TYLER "BILLY" ARMS PAPERS

Biographical: Clara Harriet Eriksen was born in Fitchburg, Mass., in 1908 to Clara and Andrew Eriksen. Clara changed her name to Masha Eriksen, and married Roy Schatt in 1934; they divorced and she married William Tyler Arms (divorced in 1938 from Luisa Arms) in 1941. After studying photography at the King-Smith Studio School in Washington, DC, Masha became a well-known photographer, specializing in portraits. She had many exhibits over the years, mainly in Franklin County, Mass. Masha died in 2005 and is buried in Laurel Hill Cemetery, Deerfield, alongside her husband. William Tyler "Billy" Arms, son of Winthrop Tyler and Jennie Chapin Arms, was born in 1904 in Deerfield, and died in 1970. William's varied career began as a columnist for the *New York Times*. His publications include *The History of Leyden Massachusetts*, 1676-1959 (1959) and *Salute to Courage* (1966). Both Masha and Billy were active in politics, town events, and environmental causes.

Their papers consist of correspondence, clippings, exhibit info, financial and medical records, scrapbooks, calendars, research notes, and ephemera. Gift of the Estate of Masha Arms, 2005.
