

Atherton Papers

The Atherton Papers consist of 8 boxes of material collected and donated by Mr. F. Raymond Hale of Gill, Massachusetts. Mr. Hale was involved in the Atherton Association, serving as historian, and an amateur genealogist. The collection consists of his notes and research into the Atherton name. He transferred most of his information into typed sheets of paper. In the correspondence, where an Atherton has been identified in the lineage, he wrote the corresponding number from the manuscripts. There a lot of typed sheets with unconnected Athertons.
