GUIDE TO THE MASHA AND WILLIAM TYLER "BILLY" ARMS PAPERS

Biographical: Clara Herriot Eriksen was born in Fitchburg, Mass., in 1909 to Clara and Andrew Eriksen. Clara changed her name to Masha Eriksen, and married Roy Schatt in the 1930s; they divorced and she married William Tyler Arms (also divorced) in 1941. After studying photography at the Kings Studios in Washington, DC, Masha became a well-known photographer, specializing in portraits. She had many exhibits over the years, mainly in Franklin County, Mass. Masha died in 2005 and is buried in Laurel Hill Cemetery, Deerfield, alongside her husband. William Tyler "Billy" Arms, son of Richard C. and Ellen Root Arms, was born in 1904 in Deerfield, and died in 1970. William's varied career began as a columnist for the *New York Times*. His publications include *The History of Leyden Massachusetts*, 1676-1959 (1959) and *Salute to Courage* (1966). Both Masha and Billy were active in politics, town events, and environmental causes.

Their papers consist of correspondence, clippings, exhibit info, financial and medical records, scrapbooks, calendars, research notes, and ephemera. Gift of the Estate of Masha Arms, 2005.
