Writer was the wife of Edmund C. Bliss, a paymaster at various mills in Holyoke. Brief entries describe social and cultural life in turn-of-the-century Holyoke. Includes observations on diet, clothing, and entertainment. Edmund Bliss was the nephew of Celia Mann Kimball, formerly of South Deerfield, who lived with the Blisses at the time of her death.
