

Cochran, Martha (1808-1872)
Diary, 1854-59. Northampton and Boston, Mass.

Cochran, a single woman, lived with her sister Mary Ann Cochran while keeping the diary. In it she records family matters, social events, and local news. She describes the marriage of her pregnant servant and mentions lectures she attended in Boston. At the rear of the volume are random notes, dated 1841, 1852, and 1872, on books read, lectures attended, and conversations.
