Cochran, daughter of William and Mary (Fletcher) Cochran, was born in Boston but lived in Northampton, MA, for most of her life. She was very active in the Unitarian Church. She went with her sister, Martha, to live in Springfield, but after the latter's death in 1872, she returned to Northampton to live.

With her sister, Martha, she spent the better part of a year abroad, arriving in Liverpool and departing from Italy. She provides a descriptive and entertaining account of people and locales. One volume of the journal is a draft. Prints and sketches of sites seen are tipped in, along with other ephemera.
