Fuller, George Spencer (1863-1911)

Fuller was born in Deerfield, the eldest child of George and Agnes Fuller. He married Mary Williams Field, daughter of Alfred Russell and Rebecca (Williams) Field, at Deerfield in 1889. By the time of his marriage, he had assumed the responsibilities of the family farm. He had inherited the family artistic talent, and painted landscapes and other works whenever he was free to do so.
