Sporadic diary kept by a farm wife living in the Wisdom section of Deerfield. A listing of deaths, and notes regarding members of the Robbins family and that of Jones' husband Amasa (1813-1877), precede the diary. Weather and local events such as a flood that destroyed the Stillwater bridge (Oct. 4, 1869) and a "great fire" in South Deerfield (Sept. 1, 1875) are noted. Jones recorded deaths, occasionally with cause, marriages, and births throughout the diary.
