

Negus, Nathan (1801-1825)

Memorandum book, Sept. 1819-April 1822

Negus was an itinerant artist and ornamental painter. Born in Petersham, MA, he trained with Ethan Allen Greenwood and John Ritto Penniman in Boston.

Brief entries list his painting portraits, signs, Masonic pieces, and other items. Also chronicles his ill health. He traveled to Boston, Fitchburg, and other towns in MA, Brattleboro, VT. Sailed to Savannah, GA in Nov. 1820. In March 1821, traveled to other Georgia towns with brother Joseph. Ended in Montgomery, Alabama.
